

About the Starry Night 5K

The Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation's Starry Night 5K shines a light on the more than 28,000 U.S. kids living with a brain tumor and helps communities take a stand against the deadliest childhood cancer.

Held in nine cities across the country, these evening walk/runs offer family-friendly fun for everyone. Attendees can choose to run or walk in the 5K or enjoy a shorter route at a relaxed pace. Food, entertainment and a kids' 50-yard dash are also available.

As the sun sets, lanterns are lit in a beautiful ceremony that honors local pediatric brain tumor survivors, remembers the children no longer with us and celebrates hope for a world without childhood brain tumors.



Although there is no registration fee for Starry Night, participants who raise \$100 or more receive an event T-shirt, free food and lantern to light during the closing ceremonies.

As the world's largest nonprofit solely dedicated to children and teens with brain tumors, the PBTF's mission is to care for families along their entire journey, find a cure for the deadliest childhood cancer and help survivors thrive. Children and teens with brain tumors are the PBTF's Stars, and proceeds from each Starry Night fund lifesaving research and support programs for Stars and their families.

Since 1991, the PBTF has invested more than \$29 million in research to increase survivorship, improve quality of life and ultimately eliminate pediatric brain tumors. Its family support programs include free educational resources about brain tumors, a toolkit for newly diagnosed patients, college scholarships for survivors, emergency financial assistance, family camps and bereavement support.
